Bike Clinic for Adults 55+ (Second in series) Tuesday September 3rd 10:00 am to 2:00 pm at the Deep River Library. Thanks to funding provided by the Government of Ontario the town is pleased to offer this program to adults aged 55+ for FREE! Participants require their own bike for this clinic. To register and/or book an electric bike please call 613-584-2000 ext. 127. The Clinic will be run by the Deep River Police and will cover the following: Basic bike 1 maintenance, rules of the road, equipment & practical Skills. You will also have a chance to try an electric bike, enjoy a road tour of Deep River, followed by a free lunch at the library.

The Town of Deep River has two e-bikes (different sizes) for seniors over 55 to try free of charge. Call 613-584-2000, ext. 127 if you would like to try one. These bikes are light enough to be pedaled without the electric assistance; you shift gears with the right hand and use the electric assistance with the left hand. You have to sign a comprehensive waiver before using these.
